

REMOTE CONTROL

- 1 STANDBY: Set the unit in standby mode; press it again to switch it on.
- 2 **SOURCE:** Switch the input source.
- 3 NUMBER BUTTONS (0-9): Press to select a TV channel directly when watching TV. The channel changes after a few seconds.
- 4 INFO: Display information of the current program.
- 5 SUBTITLE: Set the subtitle setting.
- 6 Red / Green / Yellow / Blue buttons
- 7 MENU: Display the main TV menu.
- 8 BACK: Back to the previous step.

REMOTE CONTROL PREPARATION

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Install the batteries as the following pictures. Be sure + and - terminals are positioned as indicated in the battery compartment (Fig1).

SERVICE LIFE OF BATTERIES

- The batteries normally last for one year although this depends on how often the remote control is used.
- If the remote control fails to work even when it is operated near the player, replace the batteries.
- Use two size AAA dry batteries.

NOTE:

- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long time, remove the batteries.

REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION

Point the remote control from no more than about 6m from the remote control sensor and within about 60° of the front of the player (Fig2).

NOTES:

- The operating distance may vary according to the brightness of the room.
- Do not point bright light at remote control sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote control and the remote control sensor.
- Do not use this remote control while simultaneously operating the remote control of any other equipments.







Use a Optical cable (not included) to connect the unit with amplifier or other audio decoding devices for audio signal output.

COAXIAL CONNECTION

EARPHONE CONNECTION



MAKE SURE ALL THE EQUIPMENTS AND POWER PLUG ARE CONNECTED PROPERLY AND THE UNIT IS SET IN CORRECT MODE BEFORE KINDS OF OPERATIONS.

BASIC OPERATIONS

- Press STANDBY button on the unit or remote control to power ON the unit (indicator will glow blue); press it again to power OFF (standby mode) the unit (indicator will glow red).
- Press SOURCE button on the remote control to switch the unit to ATV or DTV mode.

SELECT DESIRED PROGRAM

- 1. Press P + button to play next channel.
- 2. Press P- button to play previous channel.
- 3. Press number buttons on remote control directly to select desired program.

NOTE: Press -/-- button repeatedly to switch the digit.

VOLUME CONTROL

- Press (VOL) +/- to adjust the level of current volume.

Available range: 0-100.

MUTE CONTROL

- Press MUTE button to mute the sound, press it again to turn on the sound.

SOURCE SETTING

- Press SOURCE button on the remote control to display the sources list.
- Press UP or DOWN navigation button to select desired input source, and then press OK button to confirm selection.

Available options: Digital TV (DTV), Analogue (ATV), Component (YPbPr), AV, SCART, HDMI 1/2/3,

MULTI AUDIO SETTING

- Press the AUDIO button on the remote control repeatedly to select the desired audio language.

NOTE: To enable this function, make sure that the channel you are viewing supports multi-audio languages.

INFORMATION DISPLAY

- Press the INFO button on the remote control to display information of current programs.

TV GUIDE (FOR DTV MODE ONLY)

- Press the GUIDE button on the remote control to display the programme guide.



- Press the UP/DOWN navigation button to select a preferred program
- Press the LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to switch between the left column and right column.

When a program is highlighted on the right column, press OK button to open a menu:

- Press the UP/DOWN button to select an option.
- Press **REC** button to schedule a recording for the selected program.
- Press RED button to switch between on-air programs and catch-up programs.

QUICK SELECT

To quickly find an available channel, press the OK button on the remote control to enter the Channel List menu page.

- Press the UP or DOWN navigation button to select a preferred channel.
- Press MENU button to enter Edit mode and then you can add FAV, lock, delete or skip a channel.
- Press the OK button to confirm the selection.



FAVORITE LIST

When viewing an available channel, press the FAV button on the remote control to enter the Favorite List menu page.

- Press the UP or DOWN navigation button to select a preferred channel.
- Press the OK button to confirm the selection.

Note: To add a favorite channel, please refer to the operations of "QUICK SELECT".

TELETEXT

- Press the TEXT button on the remote control to display the available teletext information and press it repeatedly to stop playing the teletext.



SUBTITLE

- Press the SUBTITLE button on the remote control to select a desired subtitle.

NOTE: To enable this function, make sure that the channel you are viewing supports multi-subtitles.

RECORDER (FOR DTV MODE ONLY)

- Insert your USB memory device into the USB slot first.
- When watching digital programs, press the REC button on the remote control start recording.



- Press the LEFT or RIGHT navigation button to select the desired option. Press the OK button to confirm the selection.
- To stop recording, press the button to call out a reminder message. Use the LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to choose Yes or No and press OK button to confirm selection.

To watch recorded programs:

- Press INDEX button on remote control to call out the Record List menu.
- Press navigation buttons to select recorded files and press OK button to start playback.

TIMESHIFT (FOR DTV MODE ONLY)

- Insert your USB memory device into the USB slot first.
- When watching digital programs, press ▶I button to enable the TIMESHIFT function.
- Press ▶II button again to watch program in TIMESHIFT mode.



- Press the LEFT or RIGHT navigation button to select a desired option. Press the OK button to confirm selection.
- To stop TIMESHIFT, press the button to call out a reminder message. Use the LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to choose Yes or No and press OK button to confirm selection.

MEDIA PLAYBACK

- Insert a USB memory device into the USB slot before the following operations.
- Press the MENU button on remote control to open main menu. Then press UP navigation button to move the cursor to title. Select Media and press DOWN navigation button to highlight USB.



- Press OK button to enter it.



- Press the UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to move the cursor.
- Press the EXIT button to return to the previous page.

a. MOVIE

- Use the navigation buttons to select a desired folder or file.
- Press the OK button to start playback.



- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select a desired option in the tool bar and press OK to confirm the selection.
- Press the EXIT button to return.

b. MUSIC

- Use the navigation buttons to select a desired folder or file.
- Press the OK button to start playback.

- Use the navigation buttons to select a desired folder or file.

- Use the navigation buttons to select a desired folder or file.

Remote control operations when playing multimedia files:

- Press the II button on the remote control to play or pause playing.
- Press the button on the remote control to stop playing.
- Press the ◀ button on the remote control to move fast backward.
- Press the >> button on the remote control to move fast forward.
- Press the I button on the remote control to play the previous file.
- Press the button on the remote control to play the next file.

NOTE: To play your multimedia files, make sure you have selected the correct icon in the main menu of MEDIA PLAYBACK. That is to say, you can only play Photo files in PHOTO mode, Music files in MUSIC mode, and so on.

TV Cast

- Casting from your Android mobile devices
- The Cast supports playing photos, music and videos on your Android smartphone or tablet on to your TV screen.
- Make sure the TV and your Android device are on the same Wi-Fi network.
- Be sure to stay close to the TV so that you can make the initial connection easily.

Media Server

- Connect to your media stream server.
- The playback supports photos, music and videos located in your PC or any other media stream devices via the network. To use this function with your PC, make sure the PC has enabled the media stream server function.

Home page of the TV

- Press the 🏠 (Home) button on remote control to open home page of the TV.



- Use UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select an application and press OK button to open it.

Note: Before using this TV, please make sure that this TV is successfully connected to network either by LAN or Wi-Fi. For network connection, please refer to the settings of "Network"

MAIN MENU

- The unit contains different setting menus. Once the initial programming is entered, it will be remained in the memory until change, and the unit can always be operated under the same conditions.
- The settings will be remained in the memory until the settings are changed ever after setting the player to standby mode.

First Time Installation

- Connect to power source and turn on this TV, welcome page will display on the screen.
- Press LEFT/RIGHT/UP/DOWN navigation buttons on remote control to select an option.
- Press OK button on remote control to confirm selection.





Step 1

- Press OK button on remote control to start setting and select desired on-screen display language.





Step 2

- Choose the country you are living in and accept the Terms of Use to enter next step.

DTV Settings

- Press SOURCE button on the remote control to select DTV input source.
- Press the MENU button on remote control to open main menu.

- If Setting is not highlighted on menu title, press UP navigation button to move the cursor to title. Select Setting and press DOWN navigation button to enter it.
- Some options under "Settings" only appear when TV received available signals.

Common procedure for initial settings

- You can watch all recorded programs here.

- Show schedule list if you have scheduled a program through EPG menu.

2. Picture



2.1 Picture Mode

- Press the LEFT/RIGHT navigation buttons to select an option.

Picture Mode: available options: Standard, Personal, Dynamic, Movie, Economy.

Brightness / Contrast / Color / Sharpness: adjustable value: 0-100.

Note: If you adjusted Brightness, Contrast, Colour or Sharpness, Picture Mode will turn to

"Personal" automatically.

2.2 Color Temperature

Select the optimum color temperature for suitable viewing.

Available options: Standard, Warm, Personal, Cold.

2.3 Aspect Ratio

This item is used to adjust the video size.

Available options: Auto, 4:3, 16:9, Zoom1, Zoom2.

Note: The available video size may be different for different input source.

2.4 Expert Settings

Noise Reduction: select noise reduction level (Off, Low, Medium, High).

Gamma: select suitable gamma (Low, Medium, High).

Active Contrast: turn on/off active contrast.

3. Sound



3.1 Sound Mode

- Press the LEFT/RIGHT navigation buttons to select an option.

Sound Mode: available options: Standard, Music, Movie, Sports, Personal.

3.2 Surround Sound

- Turn on/off surround sound.

3.3 Speaker

Digital Output: Auto, PCM, RAW.

Digital Audio Delay: adjust this item if Digital Output and TV picture are not simultaneous.

Audio Delay: adjust this item if audio and TV picture are not simultaneous.

3.4 Auto Volume Level

- Turn on/off Auto Volume Level.

3.5 Expert Settings

Note: Only when Sound Mode is "Personal", you can see and adjust Equalizer.

Balance: adjust the balance of audio left and right.

Equalizer: adjust different frequency to get the most satisfied sound.

Audio Description: For Visually Impaired users, this function enables a user to know a certain scene or action through the narration, instead of seeing it. (Audio Description works

only when you are viewing programs that contain related narration information.)

AD Volume: you can adjust the AD Volume if you have turned on "Audio Description".

4. Channel



4.1 DVB Antenna

- Select your antenna type according to which kind of antenna you have connected. (It can't be changed for this model).

4.2 Auto Scan

- Choose Digital or Analogue tuning firstly.
- Then enter "Auto Tuning" to scan available channels.

4.3 Digital Manual Tunning

- Press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to select the channel.
- Then enter "Start Scan" to scan available channels.

4.4 Digital Smart Retune

Quickly scan channels if current saved signals are updated.

4.5 Auto update channel list

Updated channels list automatically if any updating.

4.6 HbbTV

Turn on/off HbbTV.

4.7 Standby Scan

Turn on/off Standby Scan. This product will scan channels before getting standby.

4.8 CI Information

When an available CAM (Conditional Access Module) card is connected to the CI slot, you can view related information or manage the CAM card.

4.9 Signal Information

- Display signal details, for example: channel number and strength.

5. Network



5.1 Network

- Select your network connection method.

Available options: Ethernet (Wired), Wireless.

5.2 Ethernet (when Network is in "Ethernet")

- Configure Ethernet, such as IP address and Gateway.

Notice: Connect your local network using a LAN cable first.

5.3 Wi-Fi (when Network is in "Wireless")

Wi-Fi: when entered, TV will scan available Wi-Fi account automatically. Use navigation button to select an account and press OK to start connection.

WPS: setup WPS (Wi-Fi Protected Setup): Push button method or Generate a Security PIN.

Note: If a Wi-Fi point has a security password, please enter the password using on-screen keypad.



6. Time



6.1 Time

It displays the current system time when an available channel was saved.
 Press OK to enter it.

Auto Sync: turn on/off auto synchronization. If it's off, you can see and adjust date and time using navigation buttons.

using navigation buttons.

Time Zone: select correct time zone.

Daylight Savings: When auto sync is enabled, you can see and turn on/off Daylight

Savings.

6.2 On Time

On Time: set the hour, minute and day using navigation buttons.

Input Source: select power on input source. **DTV Channel Type:** select DTV channel type.

Channel: select the channel. **Volume:** adjust the volume.

6.3 Off Time

Off Time: set the hour, minute and day using navigation buttons.

6.4 Sleep Timer

- Set the automatic sleep time.

Available options: Off, 10min, 20min, 30min, 60min, 90min, 120min, 180min, 240min.

6.5 Auto Standby

- Select a desired Auto Sleep (standby) duration when no operations are done through the remote control.


Available options: Off, 3/4/5 hours.

6.6 OSD Timer

7.1 Country

- Select the country you are living in.

7.2 Language

- Select the OSD menu language, Audio and Subtitle languages.

7.3 Lock

- Input the factory default password "0000" using number buttons on remote control.
- Then highlight "OK" on screen and press OK to enter it.

Note: If you forget the password, please use the universal password "4711".



Lock: turn on/off lock.

Set password: input the old password using number buttons and then input your private

password twice to finish it.

Channel Lock: when entered, press GREEN button to lock/unlock a channel.

Parental Guidance: select desired program rating (off, 4-18).

Hotel Mode: enter Hotel Mode.

7.4 HDMI Settings



To use the HDMI CEC function:

- Make sure the HDMI device (Amplifier, etc.) is connected correctly.
- Press the SOURCE button on the remote control to select the HDMI input source.

Note: HDMI ARC in "HDMI 3" only.

HDMI CEC: turn on/off HDMI CEC.

Device Auto Power Off: if this function is enabled, external connected CEC device will power off automatically when turn off this TV.

TV Auto Power On: if this function is enabled, this TV will power on automatically when turn on external connected CEC device.

HDMI ARC (Audio Return Channel): if this function is enabled, the users can use external amplifier or audio decoding device which featured with ARC.

HDMI 2.0 Format: Set to 'Enhanced' when watching 4K-UHD content. Set to 'Standard' when watching HD content

NOTE: This setting is only available when in HDMI modes.

Detect: detect available device

7.5 Source Rename

- Rename the name of each input source.

7.6 Expert Settings

PVR & Time-Shift Settings: you can select a desired disk, partition, Time-Shift size, format USB device and check USB speed.

Hearing Impaired: for Hearing Impaired users, this function provides captions to supplement the audio (Hearing Impaired function works only when you are viewing programs that contain related caption information)

Network Wake Up: turn on/off Network Wake Up.

Store Mode: turn on/off store (shop) mode.

Do Not Track Preference: Allow or deny to track preference under Smart TV. If you want to disable this function, just select "Off".

- Show TV system information.

8.2 System Upgrade

- Update software through network or USB memory device.

Note: Only technicians are authorized to update the software.

8.3 Reset TV

- Restore TV to default settings.



- Be sure to press STANDBY button to set the player to the standby mode and disconnect the power plug before maintaining the player.
- Wipe the player with a dry, soft cloth.
- If the surface is extremely dirty, wipe clean with a cloth which has been dipped in a weak soap-water solution and wrung out thoroughly, and then wipe again with a dry cloth.
- Never use alcohol, benzene, thinner, cleaning fluid or other chemicals. And do not use compressed air to remove dust.

Step 2


Align the stand and TV bottom and then force the end of stand until the TV is fully seated on the stand.
