REMOTE CONTROL PREPARATION

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Install the batteries as the following pictures. Be sure + and – terminals are positioned as indicated in the battery compartment (Fig1).

SERVICE LIFE OF BATTERIES

- The batteries normally last for one year although this depends on how often the remote control is used.
- If the remote control fails to work even when it is operated near the player, replace the batteries.
- Use two size AAA dry batteries.

NOTE:

- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long time, remove the batteries.


REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION

- Do not use this remote control while simultaneously operating the remote control of any other equipments.



NOTE: When the value of Treble or Bass is changed, Sound Mode will turn to "Personal" automatically.

2.2 Balance

This item is used to adjust the audio output between left and right speaker from -50 to 50.

2.3 Auto Volume Level

This item is used to turn on/off Auto Volume Level function.

2.4 DTS TruSurround

This item is used to turn on/off DTS TruSurround function.

2.5 Digital Output

Available options: Auto, PCM, Off.

2.6 Audio Description

This item is used to turn on/off Audio Description function.

NOTE: For Visually Impaired users, this function can help to know a certain scene or action through the narration, instead of see it. This function works only when you are viewing programs that contain related narration information.

When "Audio Description" is turned on:

AD Volume: Select desire volume level.

Audio Language: Select audio language if available for current program.

2.7 Audio Delay

Adjust this item if TV picture display and sound doesn't work simultaneously.

2.8 SPDIF Delay

Adjust this item if TV picture display and sound doesn't work simultaneously.

3. CHANNEL



3.1 Auto Tuning

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Use navigation buttons to set the Tuning Mode and Country
- Then highlight "Auto Tuning" and press OK to start program tuning.

3.2 Analogue Manual Tuning

3.6 Cl Information

When an available CAM (Conditional Access Module) card is connected to the CI slot, the users can see related information or manage your CAM card.

3.7 Recorded List

If recorded some programs in advance, users can watch all recorded programs here.

- Use navigation buttons to select a program.
- Press OK to play the highlighted program.
- Press **button** to stop playing.

3.8 Schedule List

If already set a reminder through EPG menu, users can watch all preset programs here.

- Press BLUE button to edit preset reminder.
- Press GREEN button to sort by Time or Channel Name.
- Press RED button to delete highlighted option.



This item is used to select desired Auto Sleep (standby) duration when no operations were done through the remote control.

Available options: Off, 3, 4 or 5 hours.

5.7 Time Zone

This item is used to select desired time zone.

6. NETWORK



6.1 IP Config

Notice: Connect your local network using a LAN cable first.

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to highlight desired channel.

Mode: select Auto to gain IP address automatically; select Manual to configure IP manually.

IP / Netmask / Gateway / DNS: press OK button to enter adjusting mode and use numeric buttons on remote control to MAC Addr: show the MAC address.

When above settings are finished, highlight "OK" on this menu and press OK button on remote to finish configuration.

6.2 Network Info

This item is used to show IP Address, Mask, Gateway and so on information.

This item is used to turn on/off Blue Screen. The screen background will turn blue at very weak or no signal condition, if Blue Screen is ON.

7.8 PVR File System

- Press OK or RIGHT navigation button to enter it.
- Press UP/DOWN navigation button to select desired option and press LEFT/RIGHT navigation button to adjust it.
- Press OK button to enter submenu or confirm setting.

In this part, you can select desired disk, check speed, format your USB memory device or set desired Timeshift size.



BASIC OPERATIONS

DVD

1. Basic play

- a) Make sure the disc compartment has no disc. Place a disc into the disc compartment. Hold the disc without touching either of its surfaces, position it with the readable (mirror) side facing towards you, then the disc will automatically enter into the disc compartment; or you can press EJECT button on remote control to enter the disc into the disc compartment.
- b) Once the disc is in the disc compartment, the player starts to read the disc immediately.
- c) When a menu screen appears on the unit, move the navigation buttons or press the number buttons to select preferred track number, then press OK button to confirm.
- d) To stop playing and return to the menu screen, press TITLE or D.MENU button.

2. Stopping play

Press (STOP) button to stop playing.

NOTE: When player is stopped, the player records the point where STOP was pressed (RESUME function). Press ►II (PLAY) button again, playback will resume from this point. When the tray is taken out or ■ (STOP) is pressed again, the RESUME function will be cleared.

3. Skipping ahead or back

Skipping ahead

During playback, press ▶ button to skip the next chapter (DVD) or a track (Video CD/CD).

Skipping back

During playing, press ■ button to skip the previous chapter (DVD) or track (Video CD/CD).


4. Fast forward/Fast backward



- d) During normal playing, press ▶ or ► button, the player will play the next or previous file.
- e) Press YELLOW (REPEAT) button to change play mode.
- SHUFFLE: all the files will be randomly sorted and played by the order.
- RANDOM: randomly select any file to play.
- SINGLE: play one file only.
- REPEAT ONE: repeat one file.
- REPEAT FOLDER: all the files in the folder will be played repeatedly.
- FOLDER: all the files in the folder will be played.
- f) Press D.MENU button to return to play list page.

8. JPEG playback

For JPEG picture CD, select the folder you want to play by the navigation buttons and press OK button to confirm. The files in this folder are displayed and select your pictures by using the up/down navigation buttons and press OK button to start playback. Thumbnail of picture will be displayed while you scrolling across the file name.

Once a folder and file is selected, the picture is loaded on the screen.

16. Changing audio soundtrack language (DVD/VCD/CD disc)


MAINTENANCE
