Suggestions for a correct use in order to reduce the environmental impact:

- When you heat up water, use only the amount you need.
- If it is possible, always put the lids on the cookware.
- Before you activate the cooking zone put the cookware on it.
- Put the smaller cookware on the smaller cooking zones.
- Put the cookware directly in the centre of the cooking zone.
- Use the residual heat to keep the food warm or to melt it."

Suggestions for a correct use in order to reduce the environmental impact:

- Make sure that the oven door is closed properly when the oven operates. Do not open the door too often during cooking. Keep the door gasket clean and make sure it is well fixed in its position.
- Use metal cookware to improve energy saving.
- When possible, do not preheat the oven before cooking.
- Keep breaks between baking as short as possible when you prepare a few dishes at one time.
