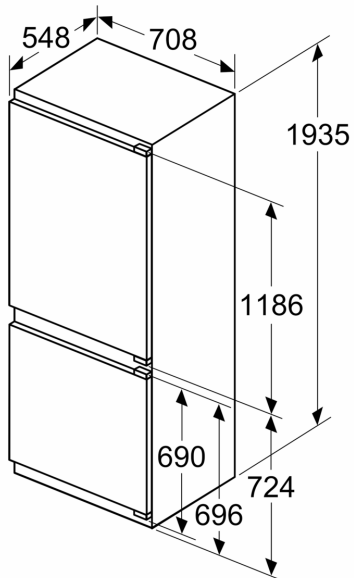

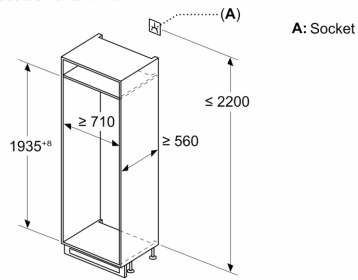
C: Front panel overhang

Maximal permissible weight of the unit fronts

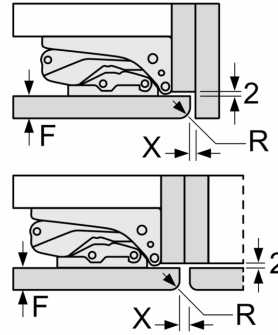
